FOR THOSE WHO HAVE NO INSURANCE OR HAVE MEDICAID

Marion County Public Health will be providing recommended vaccines for children ages 11-18 years old. These vaccines will be offered in conjunction with sports physicals that Knoxville Hospital and Clinics are offering at the dates below. You do not have to partake in the sports physicals to receive the needed vaccinations.

Vaccinations recommended for children ages 11-18 years of age are; TDAP, which protects against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough). Meningococcal, which protects against Meningitis. HPV, which prevents cervical cancer and herpes virus infections. Some immunizations are required to be current to enter most colleges, participate in teen sports, and attend summer camps. **To receive these vaccines for children who have no insurance or receive Medicaid, no pre registration is necessary; a parent must accompany the child.**
